Dyal Singh Evening College is inviting proposals from college teaching staff for short-term projects of three month duration on selected schemes and policy initiatives of the government. A rigorous assessment of the reach and socio-economic impact of the specific scheme/policy initiative is expected to be carried out. These studies will be based on field work focused on a specific geographical region, especially in Delhi NCR region which may be an urban, semi-urban or rural area. Main purpose and objective of the project to engage teachers and students in the field work research activity.

Proposals to study any of the schemes/policy initiatives in any specified area may be done collectively by a group/team of college teaching staff and students. The proposal must be based on meticulously evolved hypotheses, comprehensive and clear questionnaire and rigorous methodology.

The aim of encouraging such research is to ensure that focused in small specific area of interest with a significant sample size of the study. The researchers are encouraged to undertake quantitative as well as qualitative research of a scheme in the selected geographical region.

Research Methodology

The research will adopt a mixed-method approach, combining quantitative and qualitative data collection and analysis techniques. The following research methods will be used:

Step 1: Surveys and questionnaires

Step 2: Data interpretation

Step 3: Discussion and report writing

- Research Report to be submitted within three months of the date of acceptance.
- Research grants upto 30,000 to be released after acceptance of the research report by a Select Committee.
- · Research reports to be evaluated by a Committee of outside experts that will make recommendations to the college for consideration.
