4. “Spirit of Shaurya” - Mr. Yashpal Singh Kalsi

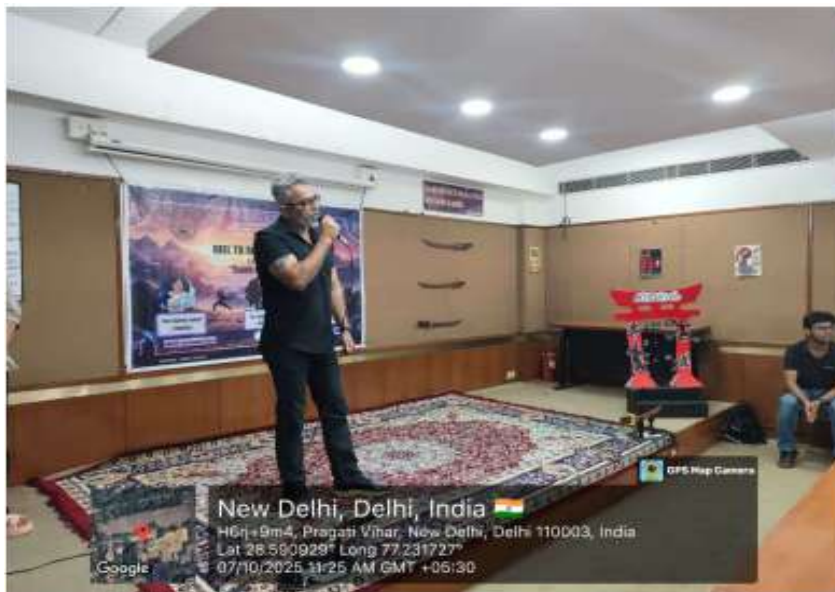
Under the guidance of IQAC, *Nirvana* organized the fourth episode of “**Reel to Real Life Heroes**” on October 7, 2025.

(11th, 25th & 28th March, 2025)

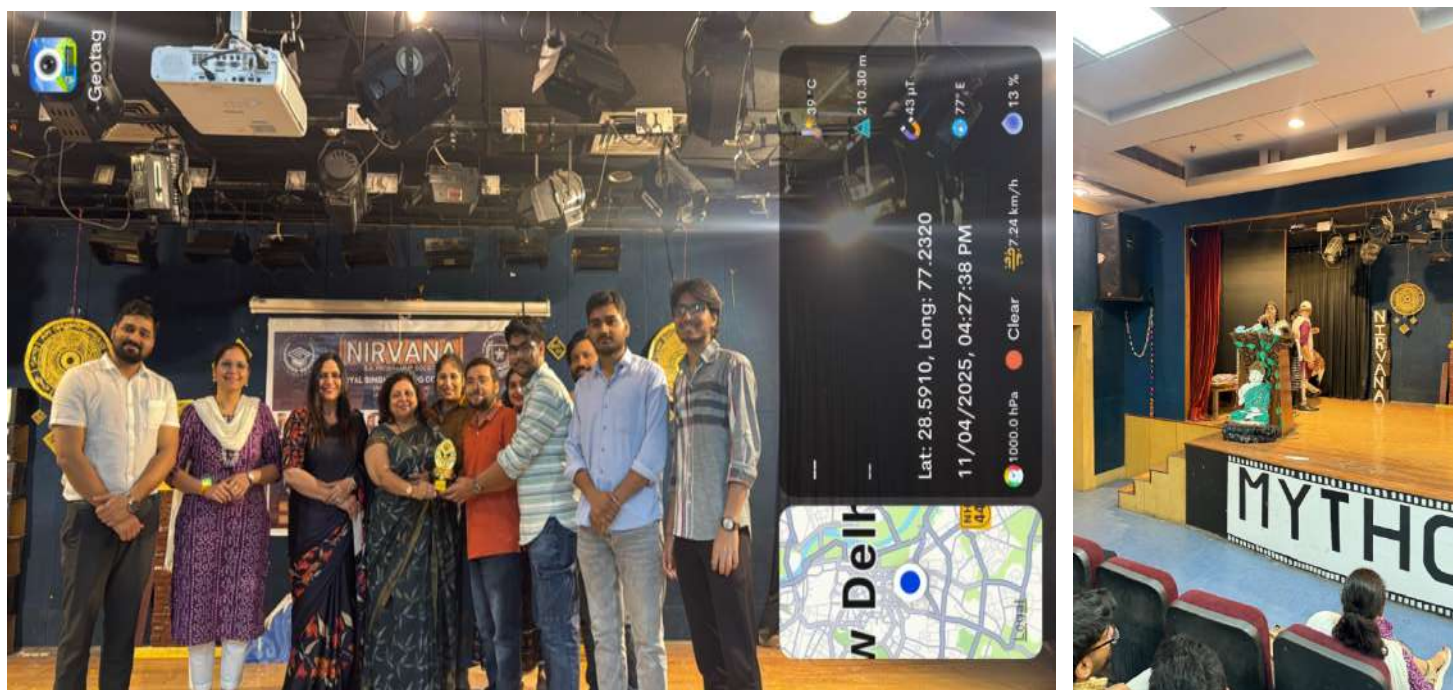

- **Mythosphere (Inter-College Quiz + Cultural Extravaganza):**

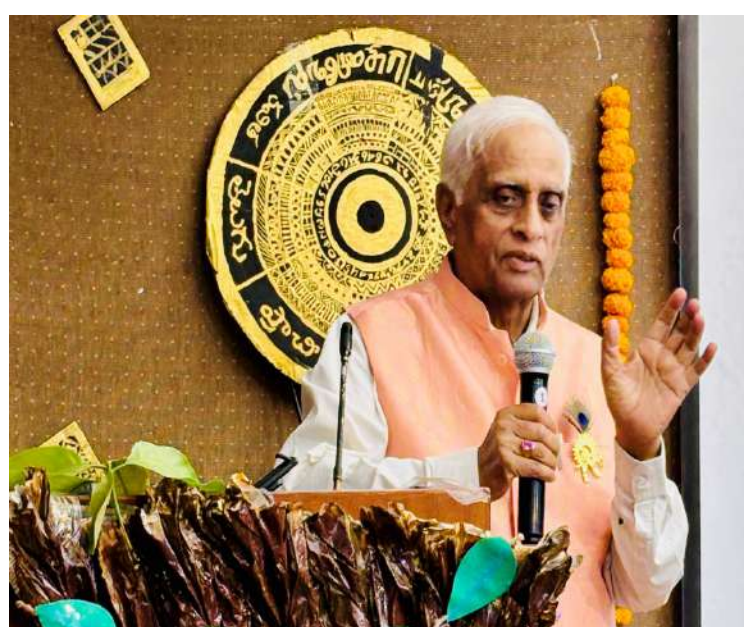
